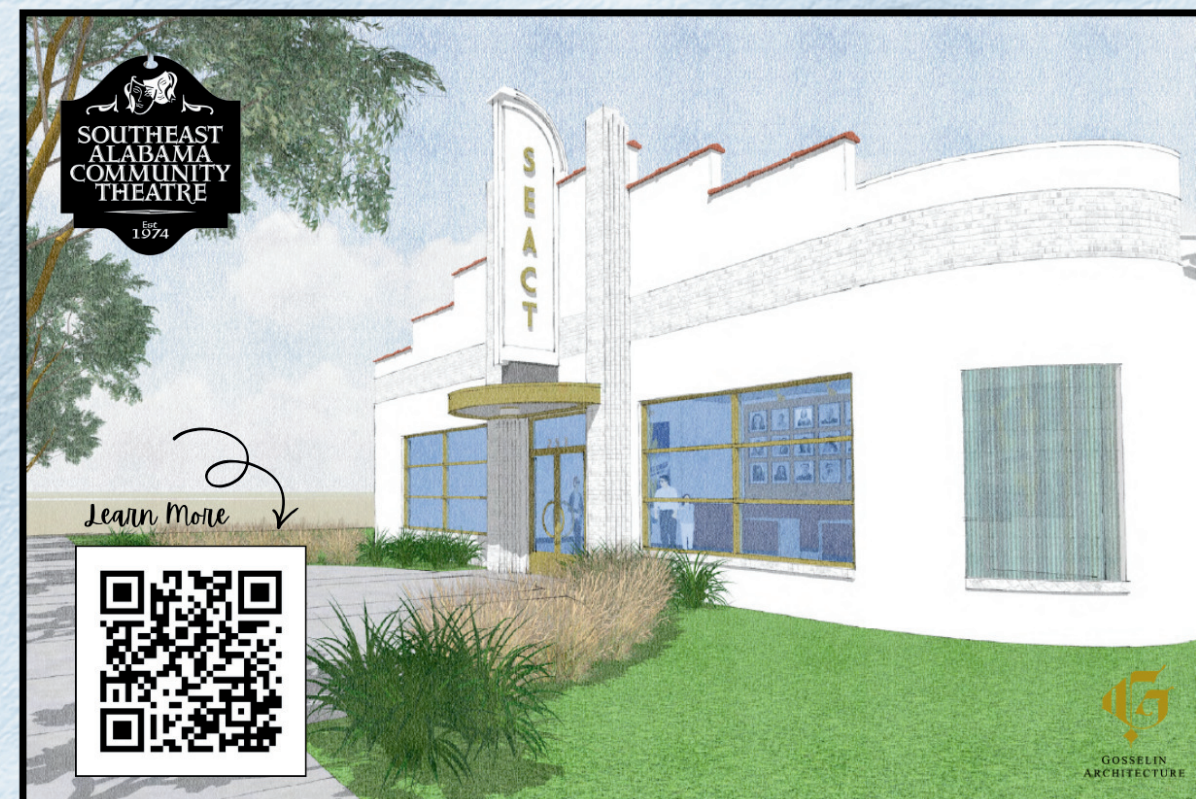

We have surprised, delighted, and even astonished each other from the SEACT stage for more than 50 years. Another 50 – **SEACT's Next Act** – is ready for the spotlight!

Since 2016, SEACT has been preparing for the closure of the Cultural Arts Center. We have been busy determining our future! We are excited to share that SEACT is more than halfway to a goal of \$2.8M to renovate a new home at 251 S. Foster Street in Dothan. This property was purchased in 2018, and a master plan was developed in 2025, to design a welcoming and accessible purpose-built theatre education facility with support from the Alabama State Council on the Arts, the State of Alabama, and private donors.

Our Phase I renovation will replace 35% of programming space, and set the stage for future development of a Phase II state-of-the-art performance venue, classrooms, storage, and support facilities for partner arts-related nonprofit organizations. **We need you to help us open the curtain!**
